AUGUST 27th

Thomas Marshall M.P.P. who is giving personal attention for the Monck part of Haldimand asks for supply of forms. Order filled.

SEPTEMBER 13th

J.W. Sheppard Town Clerk of Cayuga writes that Dunnville list was posted on the 11th September and no doubt Thomas Marshall M.P.P. for Monck will look after it. There is a big vote in Dunnville, and it is a hot bed of Toryism. Constant supervision and revision of the voters lists, one good way of perfecting our organization.

R.F. Miller evidently desires to be candidate again for the Dominion. F.R. Lalor the Conservative M.P. has strong support through manufacturing interests.
