

limit, and extend into the green Timber.

All green trees of every kind, of 9 inches and under in diameter, should be left standing.

The Forest Bailiff will be instructed to visit the Reserve and blaze the rear boundary of the burned trees, in as straight a line as may be found possible, which will serve as a boundary line for future operations.
