AIR OPERATIONS

1000 planes attacked NEUSS in the NORTHERN RHINE Valley. FREIBURG was also bombed.

EASTERN FRONT.

Fifty towns in SLOVAKIA have been captured by the Red Army in a six mile penetration.
The heaviest snowfall of the year has slowed down operation near BUDAPEST.

A Russian Communique states that enemy troops are occupying defensive posns along a 26 mile front from the Southern Limits of BUDAPEST to ASZOD on the Northeast.

ITALIAN FRONT

No change of importance reported this morning on this front.

WESTERN FRONT

The Third Army has advanced to within ten miles of SAARBRUECKEN. This information comes from LONDON.
American First Army troops have pushed the enemy to the West bank of the ROER River.
The French Radio reports a new crossing on the RHINE above STRASBOURG.

No change reported in other areas.
