Aldershot, August 24, 1941

Suggested points:

1. Greetings from Canada - whole country proud of the new Corps.
2. Appreciation of desire for action:
 - Canada a full partner;
 - Canadians to serve where most useful;
 - From outset, Allied High Command has decided about disposition of forces;
 - Regret at lack of actual combat should be tempered by realization that defence of Britain the post of honour;
 - U.K. Govt. want Canadians here.
3. So long as Britain stands, no defeat decisive.
4. Fine record of Corps - under trying circumstances, hard training: no action against enemy; difficulties of period of waiting.
5. Want to see all I can of Canadians overseas.
