INTRODUCTION

As the time has come to pass when certain reconstruction problems in hospital management face us, and as today many of the Directors and Trustees of our various hospitals of the Province are passing through great anxiety over financial problems connected with their Institutions, I have endeavored to outline a new system of Hospital financing which would relieve and make our institutions more efficient.
