"Every lodge has the power of framing "by-laws for its own government, provided "they are not contrary to or inconsistent with "the general regulations of the Grand Lodge. "The by-laws must be submitted to the District " Deputy Grand Master for the approbation of "the Grand Master, and when approved, a fair "copy must be sent to the Grand Secretary, " and also to the District Deputy Grand Master, "and when any alteration shall be made, such "alteration must in like manner be submitted; "and no law or alteration shall be valid until "so submitted and approved All proposed "alter ions must be inserted in the notice or "sum ..ons of the Lodge for the meeting in "which they are to be discussed and voted "npon."
