##### PUBLIC SCHOOLS

For school purposes the city is divided into four districts, in each of which there is a central school. Over each district is placed a head master, who has supervision not only of his own school, but also of the primary schools attached to the central school of the district.

District I. includes Wards 1 and 7; Head Master, Jehn Ross.

District II. includes Wards 2 and 3; Head Master, G W Johnson.

District III. includes Ward 4; Head Master, J S Cruickshank.

District IV. includes Wards 5 and 6; Head Master, W C Morton.

Inspector of the four districts, J S Smith, Ancaster.

The general management of all the schools is entrusted to the Principal of the Collegiate Institute.
