All goods not enumerated in this Act as charged with any duty of Customs, and not declared free of duty by this Act, shall be charged with a duty of twenty per cent ad valorem when imported into Canada or taken out of warehouse for consumption therein.

## Exports Prohibited.

The export of deer, wild turkeys, partridge, quail, prairie fowls, and woodcock, in the carcass, or parts thereof, is hereby declared unlawful and prohibited, and say person exporting or attempting to export any such article shall, for each such offence, incur a penalty of one hundred dollars, and the article so attempted to be exported, shall be forfeited, and may, on reasonable cause of suspicion of intention to export the same, be seized by any officer of the Customs, and if such intention be proved, shall be dealt with as for breach of the Customs laws .-46 V. c. 13, s. 9; 48, 49 V. c. 61, s. 12.
