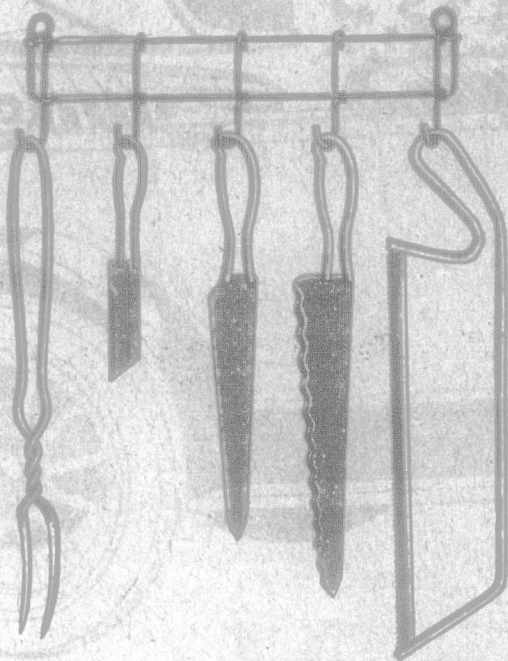

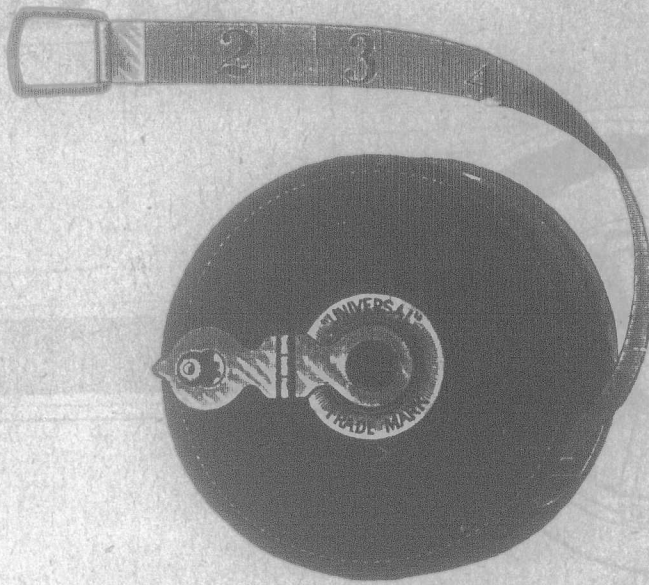
Remember These Premiums
