during the present War with the United States of America." Received by Message, and read for the first time. Ordered to be read a second time, 42. Said order postponed, 44, 48. Governor's Assent, that the House may proceed thereon. Read a second time. House in Committee. Report without amendment, 50. Read a third time, and passed. Acquiescence of this House signified to the Assembly, 52. Royal Assent, 121.

For the better support of the dignity of the Speaker of the House of Assembly of the Province of Lower Canada, and for disabling the Speaker of the House of Assembly for the time being, from holding any office or place of profit during pleasure under the Crown. Received by Message, and read for the first time, 44. Governor's Assent, that the House may proceed thereon, 48. The Bill to be read a second time, 49. Motion that the order of the day be discharged, and the Bill printed. After debates, the same was negatived, and the Bill read a second time. The same to be committed to a Committee of the whole, 56. House in Committee, 60. Report two amendments. The House agrees to the first, and rejects the second. Order that the Amendment agreed to, be engrossed, and read with the Bill for a third time, 61. Motion to recommit the same. Rejected. An amendment proposed, and agreed to. Motion that the engrossed amendment be struck off from the Bill. Rejected, 66. The Bill read a third time. Passed, and ordered down to the Assembly for acquiescence, 67.

To continue for a limited time and amend an Act passed in the 53d year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled, "An Act to grant to His Majesty certain additional Duties towards supplying the wants of the Province." Received by Message. Read for the first time, 48. Read a second time. House in Committee, 70. Report without amendment. Read a third time. Passed. Acquiescence of the house signified to the Assembly, 71. Reserved for his Majesty's pleasure thereon, 125.

To grant new Duties to His Majesty, to supply the wants of the Province. Received by Message, and read a first time, 54. Read a second time, 57. House in Committee. Report without amendment. Read a third time, 68. Passed, and the acquiescence of the House signified to the Assembly, 69. Royal Assent, 125.

To
