The Speaker refumed the Chair, and *reported*, that the Houfe delivered the Addrefs to His Excellency, who was pleafed to give the following Anfwer Thereto :

Gentlemen,

" THE due Senfe you entertain of the Sources whence the Welfare of this Province is to proceed, gives me great Satisfaction and the Difpofition you manifeft to profit of every Advantage that may offer, affures me of the Success of your Endeavours."

The House then adjourned untill To-morrow at half past Nine of the o'Clock.

Refolved, That the Bill do lie on the Table, to be committed to a Committee of the whole House.

On Motion of Mr. M^c Monagle, ordered, that Major Barclay, Major Millidge, Mr. Morris and Mr. M^c Monagle, be a Committee for the Purpose of preparing and bringing in a Bill to amend and extend the Ast for regulating and Maintaining a House of Correction or Work House within the Town of Halifax, and for binding out Poor Children.

Then the House adjourned until To-Morrow at half past Nine of the Clock.
