*Resolved*, That the Lieutenant Governor or Commander in Chief for the time being, with the advice and consent of His MAJESTY'S Council, be requested to issue a warrant on the Treasurer for the payment of the charges to be incurred by printing the Acts of the General Assembly and the Journal of the Votes and Proceedings of this House in the present session: And that this House will make provision in the next session, for supplying such money out of the public revenue.

A message from the Council informing the House that they have concurred in passing the bill "*For the better regulating the Militia in this Province.*"

Message from the Council—

Mr. *Peters*, by leave, presented a petition from *Solomon Dingee* stating that he has made preparations for erecting a Fulling Mill in *Queen's* county---and praying a bounty to enable him to complete the same—

Petition of S. Dingee—

Which was read—and—

*Thereupon Resolved*, That the sum of *twelve pounds and ten shillings* be given to the said petitioner as an encouragement to enable him to erect and complete a Fulling Mill as set forth in his petition---P R O V I D E D, he completes the same within the term of *eighteen* months; and produces a certificate thereof to this House from the Judges of the Court of Common Pleas or any *three* Justices of the Peace of *Queen's* county; and shall give security to the Treasurer of the Province that he carry on the business of such Mill for *five* years.
