Fertilizer on Pastures .

Judging by the corresponence received at the agricultural College, quite a number of farmers will this Fall apply fertilizer to at least a few acres of pasture land. The results from this practice at the college farm have been so striking that the College authori-ties feel that the practice should be urged on many more farms.

The story told by the experiments at Truro, is briefly this. The total cost of gain in live weight, including interest on investment, fencing and all incidentals, as compared with 15 cents per pound in winter in the stable, with feeds at pre-war prices.
