The plaque is to be produced by easting from a model, which should be finished with precision.

3. All designs submitted must be actual models in relief in wax or plaster of the size indicated in paragraph

1. No models on a larger scale will e considered, and no competitor may ubmit more than two models. 4. The design should comprehend a ubject and a brief inscription.

It is suggested that some symbolical figure subject should be chosen, out the following inscription has en decided upon:-

Competitors are reminded that the design should be essentially simple and easily intelligible.

5. Prizes to an aggregate amount of £500 will be awarded (in proportions be subsequently decided), for a mited number of the most successful nodels. The award of such prize may, if the Judges think fit, be made conditional on certain modifications being made in the design. If none of the models submitted is, in the opinion of the Judges, of sufficient merit, o prize will be awarded. The names of competitors will not be revealed to the Judges, nor will the names of any but the premiated artist or artists be

The models to which prizes are warded shall be the sole property of he Government, who will arrange for he appearance of the artist's signa are or initials on the finished plaque 9.
