on the day at Etaples and
Arras Cemeteries, for the visit
of His Majesty the King.It was my privilege at Etaples
to point out to His Majesty
the graves of eighteen Newfoundland
men who are buried there, and to
explain to him the significance of
the work of the War Graves
Commission, and the supreme sacrifice
made by the men from Newfoundland
in the great war.I was accompanied by Sir Frederick Ponsonby,
the King's Household, to Major-
General Sir Fabian Ware, in which
I expressed his approval
of the arrangements for his visit, and
the admirable manner in which
the Cemeteries are laid out and main-
tained.I enclosed letter expressing his
sentiments has been pub-
lished in the newspapers in this
country, and it may be that the Gov-
ernment will wish that it should be
reproduced also in Newfoundland.

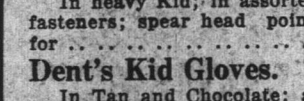
