An Expectant Crowd of Listeners Leave Disappointed.

As the Expected Circus Did Not Materialize.

Telephone Rivalry Results in a Suit Against the City—No Grant for the Mount Hope Orphanage—The Street Railway Matter Moved and Again Laid on the Shelf—A Polling Sub-Division Added to Ward Five.

A rumor had been afloat in the city, since the return of the last deputation from Ottawa, that at the next meeting of the City Council there would be some fun, presumably regarding the deputation's expenses. Accordingly there was a large crowd of spectators at last evening's meeting of the council, but the expected bill of expenses did not come up, and the meeting was comparatively quiet. As a consequence the crowd gradually dispersed, disappointed. Mayor Essery, Aldermen Taylor, Heaman, Connor, Coo, J. W. Jones, Moule, Thomas Jones, Carrothers, Scarrow, Garratt, Parnell, Shaw and Pritchett, City Clerk Kingston, City Engineer Graydon and Sergeant-at-Arms Merritt were present.

THE RIVAL TELEPHONE COMPANIES.

Hellmuth & Ivey, on behalf of the Automatic Telephone Company, served an injunction on the city to restrain them at last meeting granting the Bell Company an exclusive franchise.

Ald. Moule and Garratt moved that the matter be referred to the city solicitor to defend the action.

Ald. Stevely argued that the Bell Company should shoulder the costs of the case. If they would not then both companies could carry on business in the city and the council could collect rent from both companies for the use of the streets.

Ald. Thos. Jones—I would favor referring the matter to the solicitor. In my opinion this suit has been entered merely as a bluff.

Ald. Parnell—It is only a game of bluff. Why had the Automatic Company stood idly by while franchises have been granted the Bell Company in sixteen or more cities and made London the last suit might cost \$700 or \$800, or even more. He protested against the city going into the suit.

Mr. J. C. Judd, on behalf of the Bell Company, said that they did not want to go to court to act in this suit. The city to be out one cent in this suit. The company would agree to give bonds for security of all costs.

On this understanding the city will defend the suit.
