Nova Scotia Strikers.
SYDNEY, N. S., Dec. 10.—The strikers clashed this scene of operations this morning. About 6 o'clock a crowd of about four hundred men drawn from the various work sites, gathered at the Bridgeport No. 8, gathered about the gates and fences and endeavored to take charge of the strikers. A large force of soldiers and police were out. Their presence served to overawe the strikers and the incident was quickly dispersed. The strikers were committed to the supreme court for assaulting Policemen Morris, Angus and others. The strikers were wounded in the head, and severely hurt out of danger, but the police were not hurt. The strikers were the cause of the outrage.
