

of 2 magnifying Glafs, seem to be round and articulated, as if they were Seed-Vessels ; besides these, there are other broad Leaves, chiefly at the extremity of the Branches, serrated on the edges. The *vesiculae* are round, of the bigness express'd in the Figure.

Tab. 5. Fig. 2. *Fucus ex Nova Guinea Fluvialis Pisanae* J. B. *foliis*. These Plants are so apt to vary in their Leaves, according to their different States, that 'tis hard to say this is distinct from the last. It has in several Places (not all express'd in the Figure) some of the small short Leaves, or Seed-Vessels mention'd in the former ; which makes me apt to believe it the same, gather'd in a different State ; besides the broad Leaves of that and this agree as to their Shape and Indentures.
