I have the honour to refer to your note dated October 23, 1962 concerning amendments to a memorandum dated April 28, 1961, setting out arrangements for the co-ordination of pilotage services in the Great Lakes and the St. Lawrence River as far east as St. Regis.

I have been instructed to inform you that the Government of Canada agrees to your proposal that the amended arrangements set forth in the memorandum annexed to your note shall govern the above-mentioned coordination of pilotage services with effect as of October 15, 1962.

I also have the honour to agree to your proposal that your note and this reply shall constitute an agreement between our two governments, with effect from this date, to amend the agreement on this subject dated May 5, 1961.\*
