Created by Foreign Affairs Minister Lloyd Axworthy in 1996, the John Holmes Fund supports projects initiated by the public that generate policy options for Canada's foreign policy. The Fund is for solicited and unsolicited policy papers, consultations and other activities. Solicited projects are based on foreign policy themes developed by the Minister and the Advisory Board; unsolicited projects will respond to direct public proposals (see below for Fund criteria and guidelines).



## PUBLISHING

The Centre publishes and posts on the Internet policy options papers and reports. The Canadian Foreign Policy journal will be the home publication for occasional papers and will issue a special edition each June with our policy options papers.



## POLICY DEVELOPMENT EDUCATION

The Centre offers an education service to help inform policy discussion and to engage a new generation of Canadians in international affairs issues. The Centre's Internet site can be used for international affairs teaching and learning (social studies, history, media issues) aimed at senior high school students and teachers. This service includes teaching modules and easy hyper-link access to useful research and background material.
