University-to-university agreement covering all disciplines for the exchange of students as well as faculty members, covering all disciplines. Program due to begin operating in the fall of 1995. The exchange program is designed for the exchange of two students from each univer-

The students from Greifswald are selected by a committee of representatives from the departments concerned (for the time being mainly the Department of English) and of the "Akademisches Auslandsamt". German students should have proficient knowledge of

English, but the TOEFL Test is not required. Applications from German students should be submitted to the "Akademisches Auslandsamt" by July, 15. There is a tuition waiver for German students, but a "Sozialbeitrag" of CDN \$ 200

must be paid. Canadian students are selected by a similar committee and have to have a certificate of competence in German (but no PNDS test is required.). They have to pay their normal tuition fee in Canada, but they receive a monthly grant of DM 500 in Germany. The Canadian students

must pay the "Sozialbeitrag" at the German university as well (about DM 50). German students remain enrolled at their university but the "Sozialbeitrag" is reduced and they receive leave status. Qualifications achieved at the exchange university are usually accepted by the home institution.
