ARTICLE 14

Relationship to Canada-EURATOM NCA and Successor Instruments

- 1. The Canada-EURATOM NCA shall take precedence over the Agreement and this Protocol in those areas within the scope of the former. The Agreement as supplemented by this Protocol remains in effect for those areas of nuclear co-operation not covered by the Canada-EURATOM NCA, including any legal instrument that would amend or supersede it.
- 2. In case of any conflict, incompatibility or overlap between the rights and obligations stemming from the Agreement and this Protocol and the rights and obligations from the Canada-EURATOM NCA, including any legal instrument that would amend or supersede it, the latter shall prevail.
- 3. None of the provisions of the Agreement and this Protocol shall be interpreted as affecting the rights and obligations which result from the participation of either Party in other international agreements, including, for the Government of Romania, the TEU, the TFEU and the EURATOM Treaty.

ARTICLE 15

Annexes

The Annex to this Protocol forms an integral part of this Protocol.

ARTICLE 16

Entry into Force, Amendments, and Termination

- 1. This Protocol enters into force on the date of the last note of an exchange of diplomatic notes in which the Parties notify each other of the completion of their internal procedures necessary for the entry into force of this Protocol.
- 2. This Protocol may be amended at any time with the written consent of the Parties. Any amendment to this Protocol shall enter into force in accordance with paragraph 1.
