

THE HONOURABLE THOMAS CLAYTON DAVIS

Mr. Davis was born in Prince Albert, Saskatchewan in 1889. He is a graduate of Osgoode Hall Law School. After a number of years of distinguished service with both municipal and provincial governments, Mr. Davis was appointed Justice of the Saskatchewan Court of Appeal in 1939. In 1940 he was appointed Associate Deputy Minister of National War Services. Since 1942 he has served as Canadian Head of Mission in Australia, China and Germany. In 1954 he was appointed Ambassador to Japan.
