inhibiting factor, you can dub these into the other language. There is no technical problem in translating it into another language.

The Chairman: Well, thank you very much, gentlemen. I think this has been a very appropriate hearing which is our next to the final hearing. I think you have brought views which have been of great value to the Committee. I think it was important. We were anxious to obtain the opinions of the working newspaper men and we still have steps to take to obtain more of those opinions. We wanted to have the opinions of working members of the broadcast industry and the people who are associated with ACTRA. We are particularly grateful that you have come. I realize that it was an imposition to ask you to come down here, particularly following your appearance before the CRTC and that makes it doubly grateful.
