

ARTICLE 6 - It is forbidden to build on Sherbrooke Street exterior stairs to a flat higher than the basement.

ARTICLE 7 - All new buildings being erected on Sherbrooke Street between Gay and City Councillors, should at least have (38) feet of height, and at least three storeys, the basement being considered like the first floor.

ARTICLE 8 - Any buildings existing, erected on this side of the construction line, can not be enlarged toward that line unless an annex being added is of the same height as mentioned in Article 7 of height of the building.

ARTICLE 9 - Whoever goes against the regulations of the present rules will be exposed to a fine with or without cost, and a default of an immediate payment of said fine or of the said fine or cost, according to the case of an imprisonment will be settled by the Recorder of the City of Montreal at his discretion. But the said fine will not exceed \$40. and imprisonment will not be for a period of more than 60 days. The said imprisonment however should cease at such time before the expiration of term fixed by the said Recorder, payment of the said fine or of the said fine or cost, if this the case and if disturbance should continue, the offender would be liable to the fine and penalty each day during the continuation of the infraction.

ARTICLE 10 - It is distinctly understood that no street-car lines will be laid on Sherbrooke Street between the above mentioned boundaires.

ARTICLE 11 - The present settlement will take effect only when adopted by the Council.
