During the past year, which has been almost unparalleled for severity in a financial point of view, the receipts of the Society have fallen below the amount received in 1877.

GENERAL FUND.

(To aid in the erection of Churches, Parsonages, Education, Outfits, and for other General Expenses of the Society.)

In consequence of the low state of the fund at the beginning of the year, your Board was obliged to defer all applications for aid except for education and personal grants.

In the month of September last your Board respectfully requested the Bishop to issue a Circular on the condition and requirements of the fund. It is gratifying to find that his Lordship's Circular has met with a general response. The receipts have increased from \$1288.87 in 1877, to \$1626.54, giving an increase of \$337.67. The large and
