

made out and revised; and that the name of no person who has not a clear right to vote be allowed to remain thereon; and that the name of no person entitled to vote be omitted therefrom, and to enable the Branch Societies the better to perform such duties a correct copy of the Voters' List from each District shall in each year be furnished by the Executive Committee to the Chairman of each Branch Society to the end that enquiry may be made by such Society and a Report thereon furnished in time to procure any necessary corrections of the Roll.

13. It shall be the duty of the Secretary to attend the general and other Meetings of the League, and to keep accurate minutes of the proceedings thereat; to conduct all the correspondence of the Executive Committee and with all Branch Societies, to procure in each year certified copies of the Lists of Voters and to perform such other duties as may be prescribed by the By-Laws of the League or by Resolution of Executive Committee.

14. A General Meeting of the Members of the League shall be held Annually on the First Tuesday in January, and in the event of no Election of Officers being had thereat, the then officers of the League shall continue to act until the election of their successors.

15. Special Meetings of the Members of the League may be convened at any time and such notice shall be given of the same as the President may direct.

16. In order to create a Fund to meet the expenses of the League each Member shall pay a subscription fee yearly of \$2.50 payable in advance.

17. The Funds of the League shall be under the control of the Executive Committee.

18. That all Funds of the League shall be paid to the Treasurer, who shall keep correct accounts of all moneys which shall pass through his hands, and shall be responsible for the safe keeping thereof.

19. No moneys of the League shall be paid out by the Treasurer except under the authority of a resolution of the Executive Committee.

20. The Executive Committee shall have power to fix the salary of the Secretary and to appoint such other paid officers as they may deem necessary, and to define their duties and fix their remuneration.
