
Upwards of 100 locations have been made Toronto Mining Exchange. season in Franklin and McKinley

Upwards of 100 locations have been made this season in Franklin and McKinley Camps, which are situated in the centre of a mineral region, discovered only a year ago. The region, which promises to be another Boundary, lies 55 miles north of Grand Forks, and is drained by the east fork of the north fork of Kettle River. The Banner is practically the only claim upon which any large amount of development work has been done. A recent visitor re-ports that it shows on the surface at least 16 feet of high grade galena and copper, assaying from the grass roots as high as \$80 per ton. In a 200-foot tunnel, at a vertical depth of 150 feet, 32 feet of ore was cross-cut. The ore is of a concentrat-ing character.
