CANADA DEPOSIT INSURANCE CORPORATION ACT

AMENDMENTS RESPECTING PREMIUMS, SHARE CAPITAL, ETC.

The House resumed, from Thursday, June 2, consideration of Bill C-3, to amend the Canada Deposit Insurance Corporation Act, as reported (without amendment) from the Standing Committee on Finance, Trade and Economic Affairs; and the amendment thereto of Mr. Macdonald (Rosedale):

Mr. Speaker: Hon. members will realize that we agreed by a previous order of the House that upon the calling of the orders of the day, which are upon us now, we would take deferred divisions at the report stage of Bill C-3, and immediately thereafter of Bill C-12, and that because the divisions were deferred to a specific time, the rule limiting the division bells to 15 minutes would apply. We shall, therefore, proceed now to call in the members.
