member of the Queen square Methodist church. He was an active member of

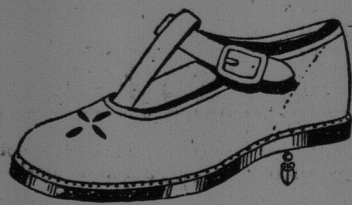

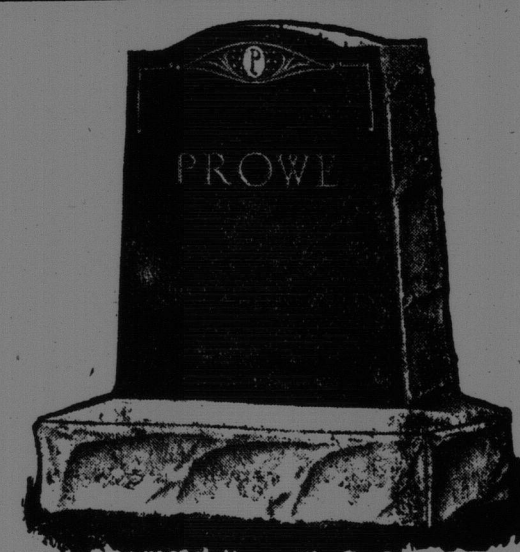
