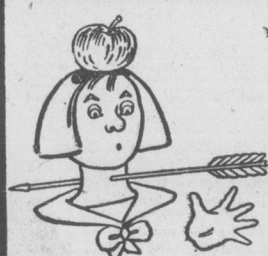

HOMESTEAD REGULATIONS

Any even-numbered section of Dominion Lands in Manitoba, Saskatchewan and Alberta, excepting 8 and 26, not reserved, may be homesteaded by any person who is the sole head of a family, or any man over 18 years of age, to the extent of one-quarter section of 160 acres, more or less.

Application for entry must be made in person by the applicant at a Dominion Lands Agency or Sub-agency for the district in which the land is situated. Entry by proxy may, however, be made any agency on certain conditions by the father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sister of an intending homesteader.

Duties.—(1) At least six months residence upon and cultivation of the land in each year for three years.

(2) A homesteader may, if he so desires, perform the required residence duties by living on farming land owned solely by him, not less than eighty (80) acres in extent, in the vicinity of his homestead. He may also do so by living with father or mother, on certain conditions. Joint ownership in land will not meet this requirement.

(3) A homesteader intending to perform his residence duties in accordance with the above while living with parents or on farming land owned by himself must notify the Agent for the district of such intention.

THREE CANNOT LIVE

Eight Wm Probably Be Total Fatalities in Steamer Wreck.

SEATED AROUND BOILERS

Number of Injuries in Explosion on Steamer Temiskaming Is Accounted For by Fact That Passengers Had Sought the Boilers For Warmth

—Man Walked Four Miles With Terrible Wounds.

North Bay, Nov. 12.—The explosion on the steamer Temiskaming Tuesday evening was an event full of horror and painful incidents. Five deaths resulted and three of the injured will likely die. The dead are:

John Menard, fireman, aged 22, of Temiskaming, died after reaching landing.

John Bergouhnan, aged 40, Ville Marie, Que., fireman, instantly killed, leaves wife and six children.

J. McBride, Columbus, Ohio, missing.

E. Chartier, Gatineau Point, died at hospital.

Unknown man missing, supposed to be drowned.

The injured are:

S. F. Laurent, Maisonneuve, seriously burned.

P. Roy, Montreal, terribly injured, condition very critical, very low last evening, and not likely to recover.

James Morrison, Liverpool, England, badly burned, may die.

C. Ryan, Ottawa, scalded, little hope of recovery.

Fred Laverdure, Levis, Que., engineer, face and hands burned, not serious.

Joseph Therrien, Hull, Que., hands and head scalded.

James Keenan, Mattawa, condition serious.

Morrison, Ryan and Roy are so badly scalded that they can hardly recover.
