FOND DU LAC, Wis., Feb. 27.—A Holstein-Freizin cow owned by J. Willet has broken the world's butter record by forty pounds. The official test shows 5,366.7 pounds of milk and 260.5 pounds of butter. The cow gave birth to a calf Dec. 19 and the test was commenced on the fifth day of her period of lactation. During the period of the test every milking was watched, the quantity of milk weighed, and samples taken and tested.
