WH^{EREAS} His present Majesty by Letters Patent, bearing date at *Westminster* the Twentieth day of March in the Fourth year of his reign, hath granted ordained and appointed, That *George Richard Robinson, Nathaniel Gould, John Peter Boileau the younger, William Petrie Craufurd, Alexander Gillespie the younger, William Inglis, John Kirkland, Edward Wheeler Mills, John Shuter, Patrick Maxwell Stewart, Lewis Stride, James Wilson, George Wildes, Robert Carter, William Pemberton, Peter McGill, George Moffatt Russell Ellice, William Robert Keith Douglas*, and all and every such other persons and person as had become or should thereafter become Proprietors Shareholders or Subscribers of or for the capital stock of the Company thereafter mentioned, in manner thereafter provided, and their respective executors administrators and assigns, should be one body politic and corporate in name and in deed, by the name of “THE BRITISH AMERICAN LAND COMPANY,” and by that name have perpetual succession and a common Seal, with power to break or alter such Seal, and by that name should and might sue and be sued, plead and be impleaded in all Courts, whether of Law or Equity; and in and by the said Letters Patent it is declared, That the said Corporation was and should be established for the purpose of purchasing, holding, improving, clearing, settling, cultivating, alienating, selling, exchanging, leasing and disposing of Waste
