Arnold, Rector of Sussex, N.B. A doctor of medicine. Sat for present seat previous to Confederation, and was Speaker of the House for some years. Again returned at last g.e., and again elected Speaker, Feb, 1871. A Conservative.—*Sussex.*

S. of the late Alex. Wedderburn, Esq., for many years Emigration Agent in N.B., and author of *Notitiæ of New-Brunswick*, by the dau. of Mr. Heavyside. B. in St. John. Ed. at the St. John Grammar School. M. the dau. of Mr. C. Vaughan. Called to the Bar, 1858. Is Presdt. of the St. John Mechanics' Institute. One of the delegates to Ottawa for "Better Terms," Oct., 1871. Was Grand Master of the Freemasons of N.B. from 1870 to 1872. First returned
