

An Act to annex a portion of the Township of Moulton, in the County of Haldimand, to the Township of Sherbrooke, in the same County, and to dissolve the Union of the said Townships.

WHEREAS the first and second concessions from Lake Erie of the Township of Moulton, in the County of Haldimand, are by a feeder of the Welland Canal separated from the other concessions of the said Township, to the great inconvenience of the inhabitants of the part so separated; And whereas the inhabitants of the part of the Township of Moulton so separated, as well as the inhabitants of the Township of Sherbrooke, in the County of Haldimand, have prayed that for all purposes the said first and second concessions of the Township of Moulton, and all other portions of the same Township lying to the south-east of the said Canal feeder may be attached to the said Township of Sherbrooke, and that the said Townships be disunited, and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition; Therefore Her Majesty, &c., enacts as follows:

I. Upon, from and after the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and sixty, the first and second concessions from Lake Erie of the Township of Moulton, in the County of Haldimand, and all other parts of the said Township lying to the south-east of the Welland Canal feeder shall be detached from the Township of Moulton, and be annexed to and form part of the Township of Sherbrooke, in the said County of Haldimand; And, upon from and after the day last aforesaid, the union of the said Townships shall be dissolved, and they shall be for all purposes separate Township and Township Municipalities.

Part of Moulton annexed to Sherbrooke, and the Union dissolved from 1st January, 1860.

II. Nothing herein contained shall affect or be construed to affect any taxes imposed for the payment of any debts contracted by the Municipal Council of the united Townships of Sherbrooke and Moulton.

Act not to affect taxes imposed to pay debts of the Union.

III. Nothing in this Act contained shall affect or be construed to affect the seat of any Municipal Councillor for the said United Townships elected before the passing of this Act.

Act not to affect seats of Councillors, &c.

IV. The Council of the County of Haldimand shall by a By-law to be passed on or before the thirty-first day of October, in the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty-nine, fix the place for holding the first annual election of Councillors in the Township of Sherbrooke, and appoint a Returning Officer for holding the same, and otherwise provide for the due holding of the election according to law.
