An Act to establish a Standard Weight for the different kinds of Grain and Pulse and Seeds in Upper Canada.

Be it enacted, &c., That the Act of the Parliament of the late Province of Act of U. C., Upper Canada, passed in the fifth year of the Reign of His late Majesty 5 W. 4 c. 7 re-King William the Fourth, intituled, "An Act to establish a Standard Weight pealed. "for the different kinds of Grain and Pulse in this Province," be and the 5 same is hereby repealed.

II. And be it enacted, That from and after the passing of this Act, the Standard following rates shall be, and the same are hereby declared to be the Standard Grain and Weight, which in all cases shall be allowed to be equal to the Winchester Pulse fixed. Bushel, namely:
