15 retary of the Association, and must show that he is not less than twentyone years of age, that he has followed medical study for not less than four years, under the care of one or more duly qualified medical practitioners; that he has attended, at some university or incorporated school of medicinc, not less than tro six months' courses of anatomy, 20 physiology, surgery, theory and practice of medicine, midwifery, chemistry, materia medica, and therapeutics respectively, and not less than one six months' course of clinical medicine and medical jurisprudence respectively, and any other course or courses which may hereafter be considered by the Board of Examineas requisite.for the advancement
25 of medical education; and all such personashall, at a regalarly appointed time and place, be examined on all of the aforesaid branches, by the aforesaid Board of Examiners."
3. This Act shall be deemed a Public Aet.
