An Act to amend the Act to incorporate the Montreal Homeopathic Association.

WHEREAS, Francis E. Grafton, John Wanless, M.D., and others, preamble. have petitioned for amendments to the Act incorporating the Montreal Homocopathic Association, and it is expedient to grant the ²⁸ Vic. cap. prayer of their petition; Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the ⁵⁹. 5 advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows:

1. The last clause of section four of the said Act is hereby amended Amendment so as to read as follows: "The said College shall be known as the of fourth sec-Homocopathic College of Physicians and Surgeons of Montreal."

2. Section seven of the said Act is hereby repealed, and the follow-Section seven ing substituted therefor: "Every person who desires to be examined repealed and by the said Board, touching his qualifications to practise physic, inserted: surgery and midwifery, or either of them, according to the doctrines and teachings of Homoopathy, shall give notice in writing to the Sec-

- 15 retary of the Association, and must show that he is not less than twentyone years of age, that he has followed medical study for not less than four years, under the care of one or more duly qualified medical practitioners; that he has attended, at some university or incorporated school of medicine, not less than two six months' courses of anatomy,
- 20 physiology, surgery, theory and practice of medicine, midwifery, chemistry, materia medica, and therapeutics respectively, and not less than one six months' course of clinical medicine and medical jurisprudence respectively, and any other course or courses which may hereafter be considered by the Board of Examiners requisite for the advancement
- 25 of medical education; and all such persons shall, at a regularly appointed time and place, be examined on all of the aforesaid branches, by the aforesaid Board of Examiners."
 - 3. This Act shall be deemed a Public Act.
