I am, therefore, bringing it to your notice hoping that perhaps, you will be good enough to take the matter up directly with the Department controlling Indian Affairs and have this condition remedied, as soon as possible. The procedure may be a little irregular, but coming through you, it will be more effective than if, we wrote direct to the Department concerned.
