I wish to advise that arrangements are being made with the Royal Bank of Canada, The Pas, Manitoba, to forward the non-commissioned officer in charge, Royal Canadian Mounted Police, Churchill, Manitoba, the sum of \$3950.00 in one dollar bills, to reach him not later than July 1st, 1946. This is an advance of \$3900.00 to pay Annuities and \$150.00 for travelling expenses.
