Referring to Department letter #3-132 dated October 10th, in connection with the schedule for the Treaty payments in the Isle ala Crosse Agency for 1925 in which the name of Stanley has been omitted, I beg to say that I have taken the matter up with Mr. Taylor, and he has furnished me with a new circular, which is herewith enclosed.

Mr. Taylor thought it necessary to make a new schedule as the dates after Lac La Ronge would need some change. It would be impossible to pay Stanley and keep up with the dates already furnished.
