
Ottawa 9th September 1904-

Sir,

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 7th Instant, regarding compensation for relinquishment of your rights in the Timber License covering the Rocmont Reserve, and in reply to refer you to communication of the 24th June last in which you were advised that if you relinquished any right, title or interest acquired by you under transfer of License from Mr. Atkinson, the Department was disposed to refund you the amount of Bonus originally paid for the License namely, \$500.00, out of the first payment of purchase money.

I may say that your relinquishment of the 27th June last was taken to be on the understanding that you would be refunded this amount.
