



Ottawa, 27th July, 1915.

Sir:-

In reply to your letter of the 20th instant, reporting that as the sale of furs has brought in almost nothing and as the fishing is restricted in the Bersimis River, and no work for the Indians, they will require assistance, and asking the Department to allow you to use your judgment in assisting the families who are in need including the hunters: I beg to say that the permission asked for is granted. You should keep the expenditure as low as possible.
