8 By the Honourable Guy
Carleton Lieutenant Governor
Commander in Chief of the
Province of Quebec Brigadier
General of His Majesty's Forces &c &c

His Majesty having been graciously
Pleased to declare and enjoin, by Proclamation
given at His Court at St James's the seventh
Day of October, One thousand Seven hundred
and Sixty Three; That the Trade with
the Indians shall be free, and open to all
His Subjects whatever; In Obedience
thereto this Licence is given unto

18 Oct 1763

to Pap unmolated, with the
Canoes and Merchandise Specified in the
Margin to
and from thence to such Markets,
or parts, as he shall find most advan-
tageous for the Disposal of said Merchandise
Provided always that such places, are not
Prohibited by His Majestys Regulations;
nor by those of His Superintendent and
Commissioners
