Issues of BSM for approx 2 months. Run was issued daily at that time. Last the run issued from an officer in the ord run. The run was always issued on parades. I, a man missed the run issue parade and reported to me later. I always gave him his issue, it was possible for one man to draw an issue for several others by stating their names and I accounted for the issue, I don't know of the men playing cards for the run issue, but Sullivan received either 5 or 6 issues of run from me on the night in question. I only kept a bottle of run in my own room that had been opened for issue. My own personal issue of run came from the same jug. I always carried the run jug, to my room from the ord run, wrapped in a gunny sack, but Sullivan was in my opinion, the only one who they had the jug in my room. Before the night of Feb 25 I had never given a run issue in my quarters. I do not think that the civilian occupants of the house knew I had run in my room as I did not go thru the house with the jug but directly up stairs to my room. I left the jug under a table, covered by a cloth in my room. It was not locked, the civilian occupants of the house had access to my room. The occupants are ~~Mr Bandier, his son,~~ Mr & Mrs Bandier and two sons, one son is approx 15 yrs.
