A recent request through the Native Brotherhood indicates that there is an interest among the Indian people in un-organized districts to promote the manufacture and preparation of their own fur into garments and other items suitable for the handicraft trade. In particular, I have been asked what machinery and what costs are involved in order to produce plucked beaver pelts.

If you have any information on this item in particular, I would be very pleased to receive it at an early date as it is a subject which I am certain will be discussed at the forthcoming Native Brotherhood Convention during the latter part of November and the first part of December.
