

3. Beaver, mink, otter, martin, pekan From 1st April to 1st November.
4. Hare..... " 1st February to 1st November.
5. Musk-rat(only in the counties of Maskinongé, Yamaska, Riohelien und Berthier) " 1st May to 1st April following.
6. Woodcock, snipe, partridge of any kind..... " 1st February to 1st September.
7. Black duck, teal, wild duck of any kind (except sheldrake and gull) " 15th April to 1st September.
N. B.—Nevertheless in that part of the Province to the East and North of the counties of Bellechasse and Montmorency, the inhabitants may, at all seasons of the year, but only for the purpose of procuring food etc, shoot any of the birds mentioned in No. 7. *And at any time of the year, between one hour after sunset and one hour before sunrise, and also to keep exposed during such prohibited hours. lures or decoys etc.*
9. Birds known as perchers, such as swallows, king-birds, warblers, flycatchers, woodpeckers, whippoorwills, finches, (song-sparrows, red-birds, indigo birds, etc.,) cow-buntings, titmice, goldfinches, grives. } From 1st March to 1st September.
