

street to the citadel, and through the citadel to the centre line of Jubilee road, and by the centre line of said road to the North West Arm; thence south by the shore of the Arm to the northern boundary line of Ward Number One, thence easterly by the northern boundary line of said Ward One to the harbor of Halifax; thence northerly by the shore of said harbor to the place of beginning.

WARD THREE.—Commences on the harbor at a point reached by the centre line of Jacob Street, extended into the harbor; thence westerly by the centre line of Jacob street to Brunswick street; thence northerly by the centre line of Brunswick street to Cogswell street; thence westerly by the centre line of Cogswell street to the road over the commons and Quinpool road to the North West Arm on the north shore of the land known as Horseshoe Island; thence south by the shore of the Arm to the northern boundary of Ward Number Two; thence easterly by said northern boundary to the harbor of Halifax; thence northerly by the shore of the harbor to the place of beginning.

WARD FOUR.—Commences on the harbor of Halifax at a point reached by the centre line of Cornwallis street, extended into the harbor; thence westerly by the centre line of Cornwallis street to North Park street; thence northerly by the centre line of North Park street to Cunard street; thence westerly by the centre line of Cunard street to Windsor street; thence northerly by the centre line of Windsor street to Chebucto road; thence westerly by the centre line of Chebucto road to the shores of the North West Arm, on the south side of the North West Arm bridge; thence southerly by the shore of the Arm to the northern boundary of Ward Number Three; thence easterly by the northern boundary of said Ward to the harbor of Halifax, thence northerly by the shore of the harbor to place of beginning.

WARD FIVE.—Commences on the harbor at a point reached by the centre line of North street extended into the harbor; thence westerly by the centre line of North street until it strikes the Chebucto road at the junction of said road and North street; thence easterly by the northern boundary of Ward Number Four to the harbor; thence northerly by the shore of the harbor to the place of beginning.

WARD SIX.—Commences at the starting point aforesaid for the boundary of Ward Number Five; thence westerly by the northern boundary of said Ward to Chebucto road aforesaid, and by the centre line of said road to the North West Arm bridge; thence northerly and easterly by the centre line of the Dutch Village road to the shore of Bedford Basin at a point formed by a line drawn at right angles from the junction of the Dutch Village road with the road along the basin, known as the Windsor road, extended into the basin at the Three Mile House; thence southerly by the shore of the basin and harbor of Halifax to the place of beginning.

WARD ONE.

A.—Bounded east by the harbor, north by Inglis street in a line to North West Arm, and all included south to Pleasant street. B.—Bounded south by Inglis street, west by North West Arm, north by South street to Tower road, east by Tower road to Victoria road, north by Victoria road to Bland street, and east by Bland street to Inglis street. C.—Bounded east by the harbor, south by Inglis street to Bland street, west by Bland street to Victoria road, south by Victoria road to Tower road, west by Tower road to South street, and north by South street to the harbor. D.—Bounded east by the harbor, south by South street, west by Tower road, and north by Morris street. E.—Bounded east by Tower road, south by South street, west by Seymour street, and north by Morris street.

WARD TWO.

A.—Bounded east by the harbour, south by Morris street, west by Birmingham street, north by Spring Garden road to Pleasant street, east by Pleasant street to Bishop street, and north by Bishop street to the harbor. B.—Bounded east by Birmingham street, south by Morris street, west by Tower road, and north by Spring Garden road. C.—Bounded east by Tower road, north by Spring Garden road and Coburg road, west by North West Arm, south by South street to Seymour street, east by Seymour street to Morris street, and south by Morris street to Tower road. D.—Bounded east by the harbor, south by Bishop street, west by Pleasant and Barrington street to Blowers street, north by Blowers street to Granville street, east by Granville street to Salter street, and north by Salter street to the harbor.
