

This section traverses the Rocky and Selkirk Mountains, and for part of the distance lies in the Rocky Mountain trench; 2, from Blue River to Ashcroft. This section is through the

belt of the interior plateaus; 3, from Ash croft to Rosedale. Traversing the Coast Range; 4, the Fraser Delta from Rosedaie to Vancouver. The formation through the first of these sections consists of sandstone,
