Refolutions of the House on Ways & Means for supplying the Deficiencies of the Funds.

The House resumed the Consideration of Ways and Means for supplying the Desiciencies of the Province Funds.

Resolved, That a Bill be prepared for granting an Aid to His Majesty by a Tax upon certain Lands granted in this Province, and that the said Tax be 1-8th of id. per Acre.

Refolved, Also that Bills be prepared to continue the following Acts to the 1st July 1771, viz.

The AEt for laying a Duty of Excise on Wines sold within or brought into this Province;

The Act for suppressing unlicensed Houses, and granting to His Majesty a Duty on Persons licensed;

The AEI for amending, rendering more effectual and reduce into one AEI the several Laws relating to the Duties of Excise on Rum and other distilled Spirituous Liquors; And

The Act for amending, rendering more effectual, and reduce into one Act the several Laws relating to the Duties of Impost on Beer, Rum, &c.
